EXCITING NEWS!

In November of 2017 we were able to purchase 4.62 acres in Palmer, Alaska for our missionary base of operations. This past August we cleared trees and built a road in preparation for building our first building in May 2019.



Please take time to read this brochure which outlines the vision for building a much needed garage to house our vehicles and tools from the harsh Alaskan winter. It will also be able to house and feed one team till we make a larger bunk house in the future.

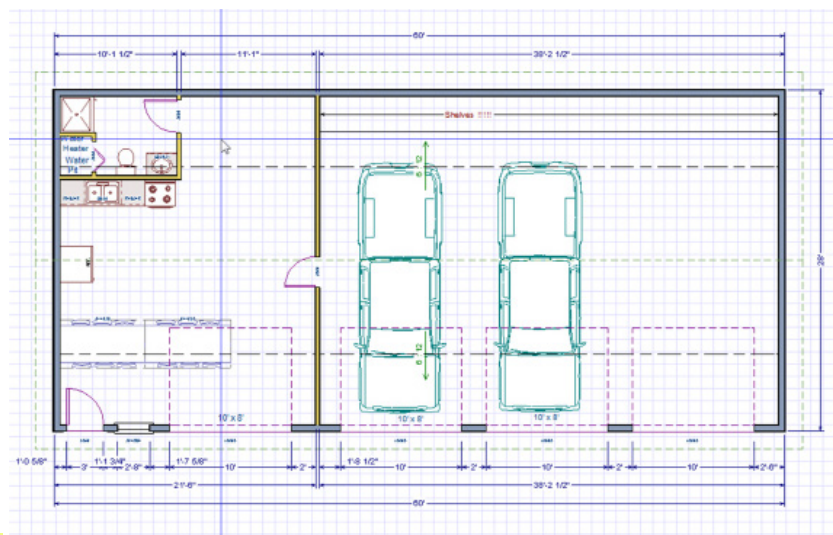

PHASE 3 - May/June 2019 Building Our Much Needed Garage



In this photo, you will see the approximate location of our 28'x60' garage. This garage will have a kitchen, dining room and bathroom in the walk-in door area and steps to go upstairs where there will be an area to set up our cots for housing teams till we are able to build our main bunk house in the future (Phase 4). The following teams are ready to build in May & June!

HERE IS OUR 5 YEAR PLAN:

Our property currently has a 2 bedroom house on it which we will continue to rent until we can place several staff people there to be caretakers of our missionary base.

PHASE 1 - 2017 *Completed!*

Praise Him! We are very thankful that God's people gave towards the purchase of this property which we purchased for \$100,000!

PHASE 2 - 2018 *Completed!*

We had a very productive series of teams in August clearing land, cutting in a new road, and renovating a small building that will be used for a cook house. \$18,300 was spent for completing this phase.

PHASE 3 - 2019

Please consider giving to help us purchase the building materials for this much needed garage. We desire to keep our vehicles and tools inside over the harsh Alaskan winter. This building will also be a temporary facility to house our teams until we are able to build a larger bunk house in the future. **The total estimated costs (to the left) totals \$77,500.**

PHASE 4 - 2020-2022

The long-term goal will be building our main bunk house that will house our teams for future service.
