My team (pictured here) will be leaving for Alaska on May 27. We will be doing some important physical work at our missions base. Last year, a lot of construction left the base with heaps of branches and stumps and lots of exposed dirt. This past February I was able to lead a team that burned those piles. But this team will be working hard to do some final cleanup using some heavy equipment but also lots some hand tools. Our goal is to move in a lot of topsoil and plant grass.
