
SHEEP MOUNTAIN

Plan on a 5 -6 hour round trip to travel the Glenn Highway up to Gunsight Mountain and Eureka Roadhouse. Eureka is a great turn around and they are known for their Bear Claw Pastries. Gunsight Mountain is 15 miles beyond Sheep Mountain.


Matanuska Glacier Tour - cost \$30/person or you can stop at Glacier View Elementary School and view it from their backyard for free.

HATCHER PASS

INDEPENDENCE MINE

HATCHER PASS TYPICALLY OPENS IN JULY AND YOU CAN DRIVE FROM PALMER TO WILLOW. BEFORE IT OPENS, YOU CAN DRIVE PART WAY UP FROM THE PALMER SIDE TO INDEPENDENCE MINE IN MAY/JUNE.

NOTE: THERE IS A \$5 NATIONAL PARK FEE PER VEHICLE IF YOU WANT TO PARK AND WALK UP TO THE MINE WHICH IS ABOUT A MILE FROM THE PARKING LOT. EASY WALKING.





DRIVING UP TO INDEPENDENCE MINE

TURNIGAIN ARM

BELUGA POINT

TURNIGAIN ARM/BELUGA POINT IS LOCATED 20 MILES SOUTH OF ANCHORAGE ALONG THE SEWARD HIGHWAY. DURING HIGH TIDE YOU CAN SOMETIMES SEE BELUGA WHALES. CHECK THE TIDE CHART FOR COOK INLET BEFORE LEAVING TO CATCH HIGH TIDE.

THERE IS A PULL-OFF WHERE YOU CAN PARK, WALK OVER THE RAILROAD TRACKS AND CLIMB ROCKS TO VIEW THE WHALES.



HIKING LAZY MOUNTAIN, PALMER







LOCATION

THE TRAIL HEAD IS LOCATED A FEW MILES FROM BASE CAMP ON S. HUNTLEY ROAD.

LAZY MOUNTAIN TRAIL

A 3,000 FT. CLIMB STRAIGHT UP THE MOUNTAIN. STEEP INCLINES, CAN BE SLIPPERY AND MUDDY DEPENDING ON THE TIME OF THE YEAR.

LAZY MOOSE TRAIL



LOCATED ALONG A 1.5 MILE LOOP THAT
YOU CAN WALK OR DRIVE TO VIEW
RESIDENT ALASKAN WILDLIFE.

DRIVING TO HOMER

ALYESKA AERIAL TRAM

Take a three to seven-minute scenic ride from Alyeska Resort to the top of Mt. Alyeska. At an elevation of 2300 feet, witness frosty views of the Turnagain Arm, up to seven "hanging" glaciers and endless peaks deep into the Chugach Mountain range. The tram operates at a faster speed in the winter to get eager skiers on the slopes.

THERE ARE BEAUTIFUL SIGHTS ALL THE WAY TO HOMER INCLUDING DRIVING ALONG THE AQUA BLUE WATERS OF THE KENAI RIVER.

ONCE IN HOMER - VISIT THE HOMER SPIT AND DRIVE UP SKYLINE DRIVE OVERLOOK TO VIEW KACHEMAK BAY AND THE SPIT.

LOCATED AN HOUR SOUTH OF ANCHORAGE - ABOUT 40 MINUTES SOUTH OF BELUGA POINT.


WHITTIER IS A SMALL FISHING TOWN LOCATED ON THE EDGE OF PRINCE WILLIAMS SOUND AND THE ONLY WAY IN AND OUT OF THE TOWN IS THROUGH THE ANTON ANDERSON MEMORIAL TUNNEL - A 2.5 MILE LONG COMBINED RAILROAD AND HIGHWAY TUNNEL.

IF YOU ARE DRIVING THE LIGHTSHINE TRUCK - THE COST IS \$13/VEHICLE. IF YOU HAVE THE LIGHTSHINE VAN AND/OR THE TRUCK AND SMALL TRAILER - THE COST IS \$38 PER VEHICLE - ROUND TRIP. YOU ONLY PAY AS YOU ENTER THE TUNNEL/TOWN.

IT'S A SMALL TOWN WITH UNIQUE SHOPS, BEAUTIFUL WATERFALLS, AND NEAT SEA PORT.

PLAN TO SPEND AROUND 2 HOURS IN TOWN. SINCE THE TUNNEL IS ONE WAY IN AND ONE WAY OUT, YOU HAVE TO FOLLOW THE CHART ON THE BROCHURE THEY GIVE YOU AND WATCH THE TIMES AS TO WHEN THE TUNNEL WILL BE OPEN TO LEAVE TOWN.






SIMPSON HILL ASSEMBLY OF GOD




